To date, we have had the opportunity to move forward with some candidates, but our committee has decided not to move forward because we did not feel they were highly compatible with our congregation's needs and desires. As a result we anticipate that the next few months will be spent focusing our attention on candidates that we feel would be highly compatible with our congregation, in preparation to move quickly when that window opens. We have a robust list of candidates but we continue to be open to any suggestions from the congregation for names to consider, and welcome your communication with us. We continue to ask for your prayers, specifically that God would give us wisdom and discernment as we go through profiles and review sermons, and also that God would be working ahead of us to soften the heart of our next pastor to be sensitive to God's call to serve in our congregation. Additionally, we'd like to thank you as a congregation for making our task a pleasant one. We have opportunity to converse with pastors about what God is clearly doing among our congregation. We get to talk about seasoned saints who love the church, young adults and families who are invested in this body, and all of the members who give of their time and resources so generously in the life of our church. We have a vibrant (even if imperfect) congregation to be part of and to invite a pastor to shepherd.
